Report from the 2nd European Congress on Physiotherapy Education (25 – 28 September 2008, Stockholm, Sweden)

1. Formal balance:

A total of **430** participants from **31** countries had been present at the European Congress on Physiotherapy Education. There was a waiting list of 50 persons

The number of **papers** accepted: **76** The number of **posters** presented: **86**

The number of key note: 4

The number of Symposia accepted: 3

The number of Parallel platform presentations: $3 \times 4 \times 8 = 76$ (Three different

occasions, eight parallels with four presentations in each session)

The number of Parallel poster presentations: $2 \times 5-6 \times 8 = 86$ (Two occasions, eight parallel sessions with five to six presentations in each session)




2. Qualitative balance and Post Congress Seminar:





